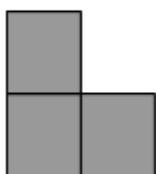

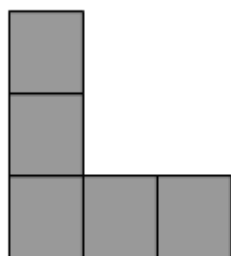

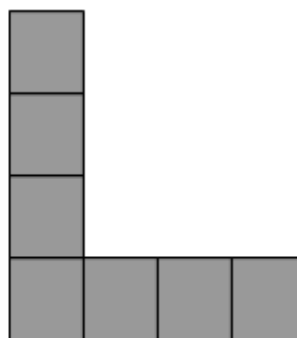
2. Look at the patterns below. The length of **one side of a square tile is 2 cm**.

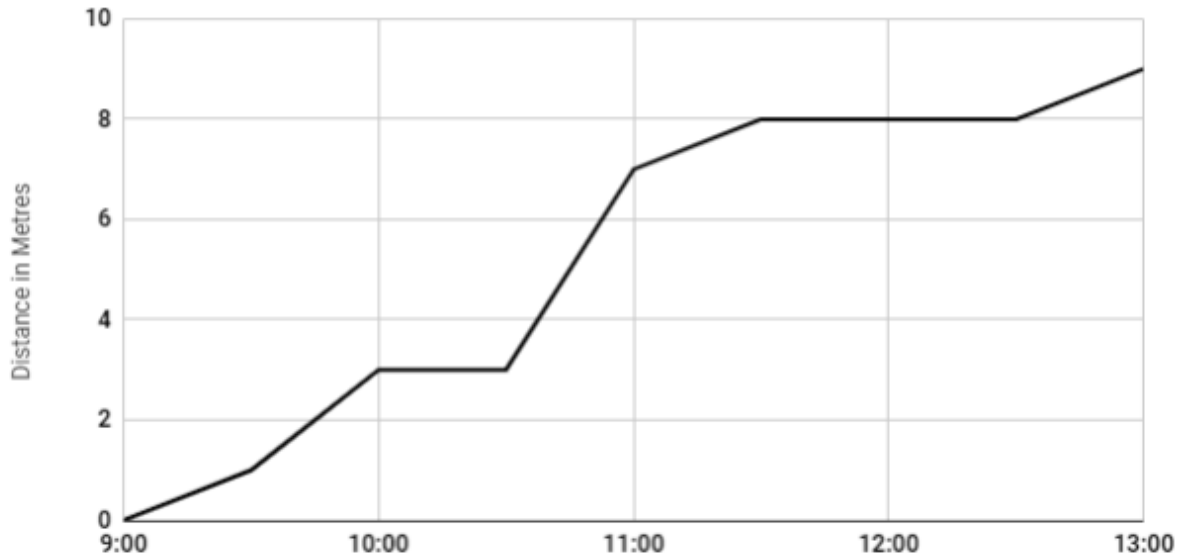
