



1 How many numbers between 30 and 50 are odd numbers but not multiples of 7?

2 A train leaves the station with 12 passengers on board. The train must stop 3 times on route to its final destination. You can see below in the table the number of passengers that get on and off at each stop.


Stop	Number of passengers getting off $-$	Number of passengers getting on $+$
