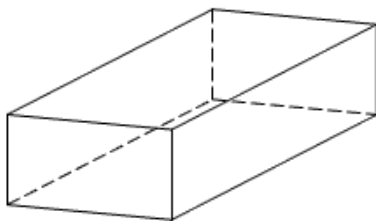
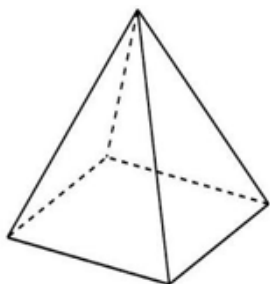

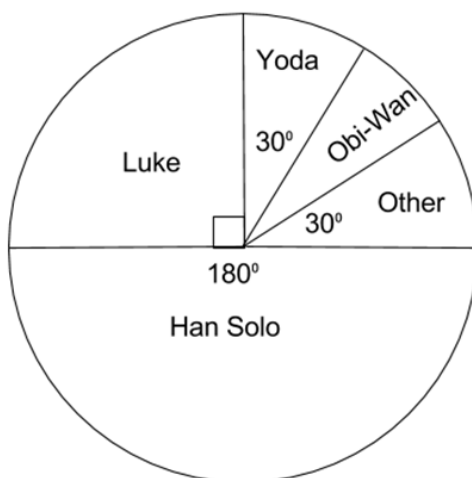


How many edges are there in total on the square based pyramid, the cuboid and the triangular prism shown above?

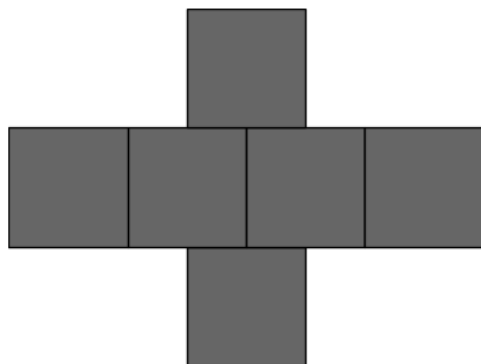
Look again at the pie chart in question 2.

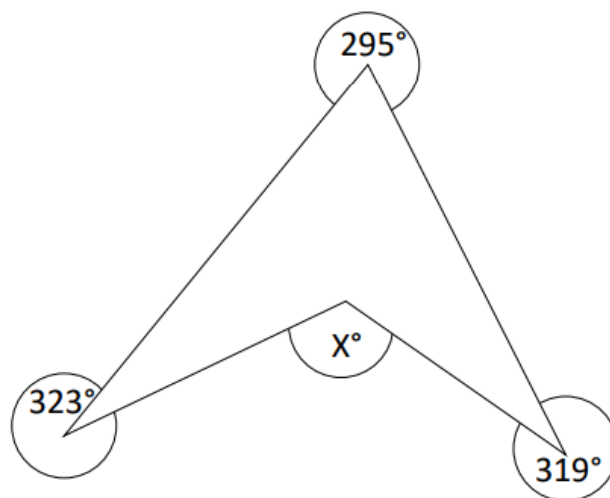
