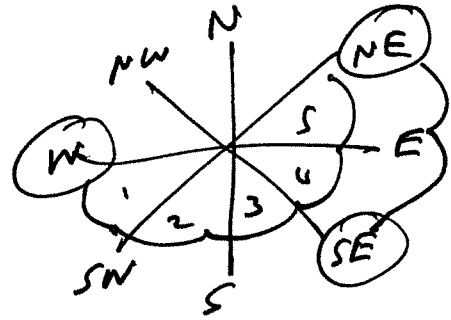

He runs 4.6km in total.

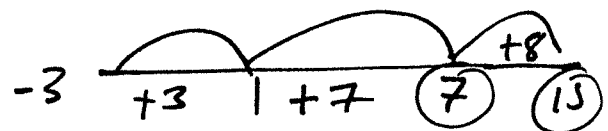
