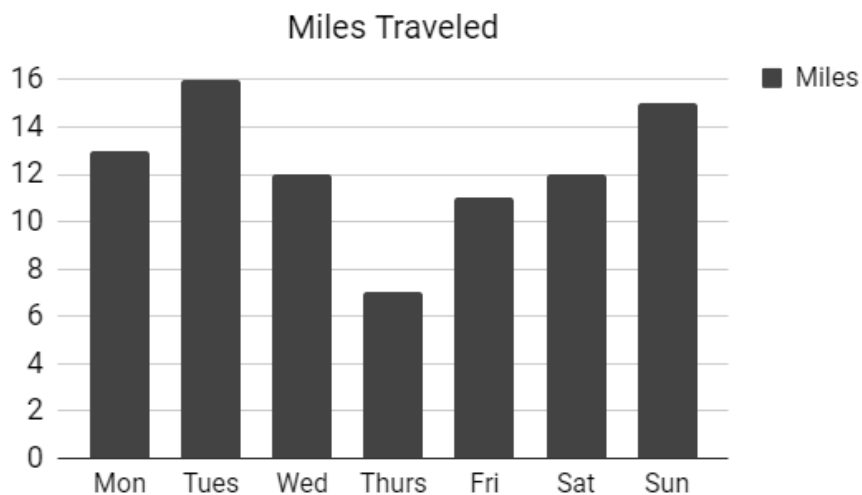

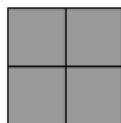

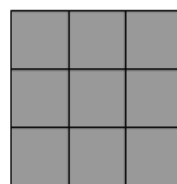
The patterns below are made from square tiles. Each tile has a side length of 2 cm.
