1. B ( $07:26$  to  $08:19 = 53$  minutes)
2. A ( $£30 - £26.51 = £3.49$ )
3. C ( $£3.25 + 5 \times 60p = £6.25$ )
4. C ( $4.1 \times 7 = 28.7$  km)
5.  $9 \text{ cm}^2$  (perimeter  $12 \text{ cm} \rightarrow$  square side  $3 \text{ cm} \rightarrow 3 \times 3 = 9 \text{ cm}^2$ )

1. A ('when'  $\rightarrow$  'When' — capital letter to start)
2. B (missing commas: apples, crisps and juice)
3. B ('childrens'  $\rightarrow$  'children's')
4. N (no mistake)
5. B ('france'  $\rightarrow$  'France')
