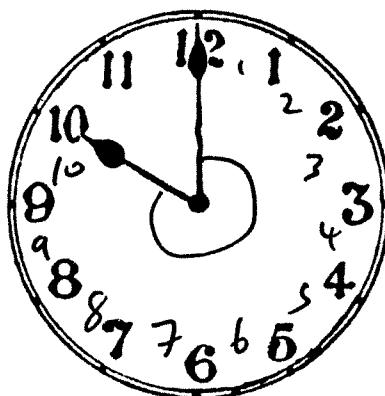

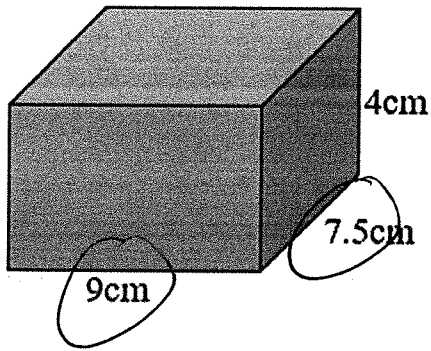

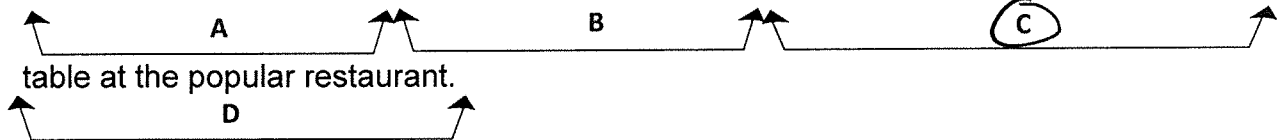
The climbers were definitely exhausted as they reached the summit before the storm clouds gathered over the distant valley below.

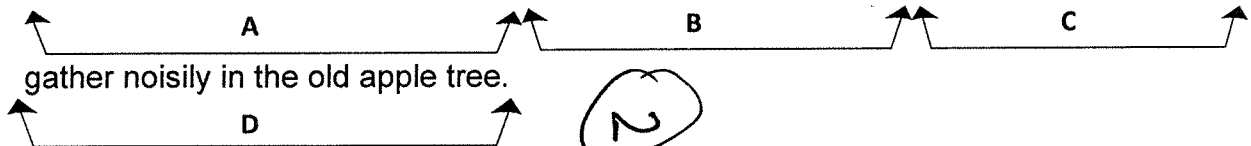
Necessary

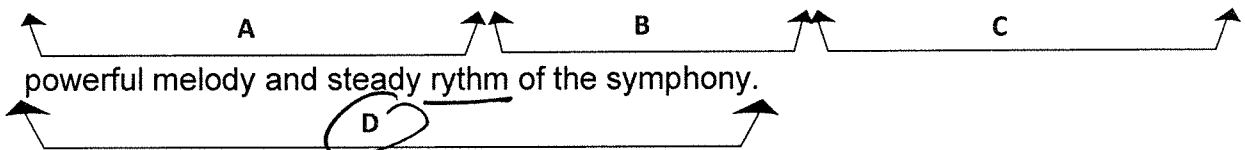
Every spring, the gardener planted rows of colourful vegetables and watched the birds gather noisily in the old apple tree.

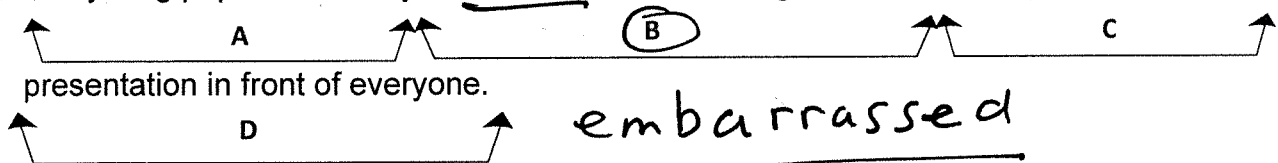
The orchestra practised for hours each evening, hoping the audience would enjoy the powerful melody and steady rythm of the symphony.
