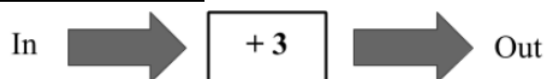

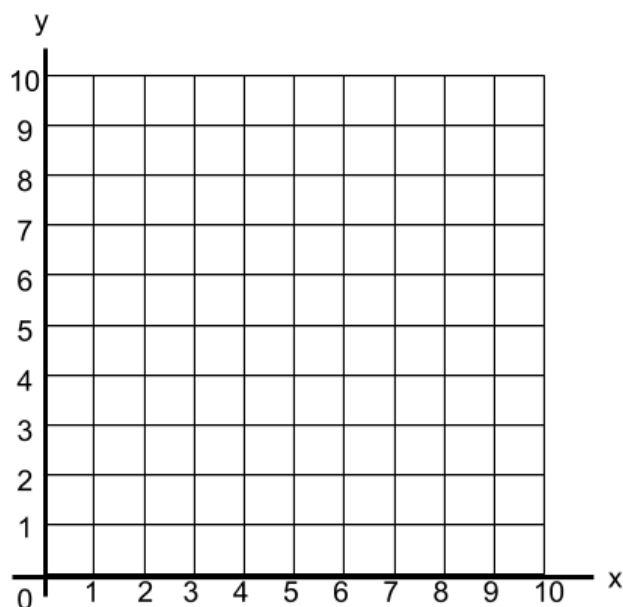

2. C ($17:10 - 55 \text{ min} = 16:15 = 4:15 \text{ pm}$)
3. D ($2\frac{1}{4} \text{ turns} = 810^\circ$, $+ 113^\circ = 923^\circ$)
4. C (Function Machine 3)

Punctuation

1. A ('on' → 'On', capital to start)
2. B ('boys' → 'boy's' — the handwriting of one boy)
3. N (no mistake)
4. B (missing commas: bread, cheese, apples and juice)
5. D (missing question mark: '...to the museum?')
